Alternative guided city-tours on classic bicycles

With a maximum number of eight participants each tour is designed to keep a familiar atmosphere and to allow flexibility for individual requests. By visiting locations that represent the cityscape, participants get an impression of life in Berlin. "The purpose of the tours is to help our guests personally connect with the city and its people rather than merely looking at tourist sights" says Balaš when asked about the idea of FindingBerlin-Tours.
